

**MATTOON CITY WIDE CLEAN-UP**  
**SATURDAY MAY 19, 2012**  
**MATTOON YARD WASTE FACILITY**

The City of Mattoon will be conducting a City wide clean-up day from 8 A.M. to 11 A.M. on Saturday, May 19, 2012. The City will have dumpsters available at the Yard Waste Facility at Shelby Avenue and Logan Street.

The dumpsters are open to Mattoon residents only. A Driver's License, or Water Bill Stub, with a Mattoon city address is required in order to dispose of material at the site. The site is open for residential clean-up only. The site will not be open to commercial contractors. Load size will be limited to 1 ton trucks and trailers.

Waste must be pre-sorted for disposal as follows:

Veolia Environmental Service Dumpsters - All waste except; Landscape Waste, Liquid Wastes, Fluorescent Light Bulbs, Appliances, Car Parts, Tires, Batteries, Concrete, Brick, Rock, Soil, or Ashes.

General Steel & Metals Dumpsters - Metals including Appliances and Car Parts.

Yard Waste Pile #1 - Landscape Waste including Leaves, Grass Clippings, and other Plant Material.

Yard Waste Pile #2 - Tree Limbs.

Neal Tire & Auto Service - Passenger car tires and light truck tires may be taken to Neal Tire at 1800 Lake Land Boulevard.

Battery Specialist's - Batteries may be taken to Battery Specialist's at 309 North 15th Street.

Residents are asked to line up on Shelby Avenue entering from 6th & Shelby. The City will have personnel available to supervise traffic and unloading. Residents are required to off-load their own vehicles and trailers. City personnel will have equipment available to pick-up heavy material off the ground when needed.

The City will not be conducting City-wide curb side collection. The City will provide curb side pick-up for senior citizens, or persons with disabilities, who can not otherwise get their waste to the facility. Those residents can call 235-5171, 7 A.M. to 3 P.M., Monday thru Friday to make arrangements. Special accommodation requests must be called in by noon on Wednesday, May 16. Special accommodations must be at the curb for collection no earlier than Tuesday, May 15 and no later than 8 A.M. on Thursday, May 17.
