CITY OF MATTOON, ILLINOIS

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-5413

ORDINANCE APPROVING AND CAUSING PUBLICATION OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF MATTOON, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code requires the City Council of the City of Mattoon, Illinois to cause to be published each year a map showing the existing zoning classifications and revisions made during the preceding year and the map so published shall be the Official Zoning Map for the City of Mattoon; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Office has submitted a request to approve the revised Official Zoning Map; and

WHEREAS, after due and proposed consideration, the Mattoon City Council has deemed it to be in the best interest of the City of Mattoon to approve the new Official Zoning Map.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MATTOON, COLES COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. The attached map entitled Official Zoning Map of Mattoon, Illinois dated March 31, 2019 is hereby approved as the Official Zoning Map of the City of Mattoon, Illinois pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code and Section 159.20 of the Mattoon Code of Ordinances, which said map reflects the correct location of the official zoning districts in the City of Mattoon between March 31, 2018 and March 31, 2019.

Section 2. Updated versions of the Official Zoning Map may be printed in the interim between the approval of this Official Zoning Map and the approval of the Official Zoning Map next year.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish a full-sized copy of the Official Zoning Map and to make copies available in her office for inspection and purchase by the public.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the Corporate Authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

Commissioner Hall seconded by Commissioner Cox moved to adopt Ordinance No. 2019-5414, establishing a six-month moratorium on the issuance of ambulance service licenses.

CITY OF MATTOON, ILLINOIS

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-5414

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SIX-MONTH MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF ANY AMBULANCE SERVICE LICENSES

WHEREAS, the City of Mattoon ("City") is a municipal corporation organized and existing under the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the City has established a set of regulations concerning Private Medical Transportation; Ambulance Code; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted regulations and performance standards for ambulance services; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined the Code of Ordinances and the regulations which apply to ambulance services require study and possible revision for proper regulation of private medical transportation in order to determine the proper number of licenses, effects of such number and to promote timely and appropriate emergency care for the public health, safety, and welfare of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mattoon believes that Mitchell Jerdan Ambulance Service has proven to provide capable services to the citizens of Mattoon and will continue to provide these services during this period of evaluating the Emergency Medical Transportation; Ambulance Code; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City have determined that it would not be in the best interests of the City and its residents to issue any permits for any new ambulance service until the City has carefully examined all applicable regulations, administrative rules, potential effects, and possible amendments to the City's Code; and

WHEREAS, a municipality may suspend and deny the issuance of any new application

for ambulance service while it is actively involved in considering amendments to relevant provisions of its code, ordinances, rules and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MATTOON, COLES COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in the Section 1.

Section 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF TEMPORARY MORATORIUM.

- A. A Temporary Moratorium shall be, and is hereby, established on the receipt of applications for, the processing of, the approval of, and the issuance of all licenses relating to ambulance services not issued as of the date of this Ordinance ("Temporary Moratorium").
- B. The Temporary Moratorium established in Subsection 2.A of this Ordinance shall be, and is hereby, established for a period of six months from the effective date of this Ordinance, which period shall expire at 12:01 AM on September 20, 2019, unless prior to that time the Mayor and City Council, in their sole and absolute discretion, terminate such Temporary Moratorium by ordinance duly adopted.
- **Section 3.** At the time of passage of this Ordinance, there are no pending applications of any kind for ambulance service license and therefore no provision needs to be made for any such pending applications.
- **Section 4.** The Mayor and City Council have determined the six-month moratorium established by this Ordinance which enable the City to examine regulations pertaining to Private Medical Transportation, ambulance service license, is a matter of public necessity.
- **Section 5.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.
- **Section 6.** All prior Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.
- **Section 7.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Mayor Gover opened the floor for Public comments. Mr. Randy Hausle, 400 Crestview Drive, questioned the moratorium and elimination of the ambulance service. Administrator Gill and Council explained the moratorium and reasons for the elimination of the ambulance service. Mr. Kenny Clatfelter, 2720 Brian Drive, provided his opinion on the ambulance service and the Fire union contract. Council and Administrator Gill explained the City's position and lack of negotiating by the Fire union. Ms. Sheila Monroe, 408 Crestview, requested the Council to meet with businesses to address other issues within the City. Council noted the work of Mattoon in Motion and the need to public address issues through an open meeting. Mayor Gover and Commissioner Hall stated they could attend a meeting with Ms. Monroe and referred Ms. Monroe to contact Administrator Gill to coordinate. Ms. Terry Landrus, 2920 Richmond, questioned the budget meetings. Administrator Gill noted the Public Hearing on the budget to be conducted at the April 2nd Council meeting. Mayor Gover noted the publication of previous budget meetings and encouraged attendance at the open meeting. Mr. Fred Reynolds, 3008 Prairie Avenue, provided the Council with four reasons (paramedic employment turnovers, manpower, response time and customer service) to have the Firefighter/Paramedics dispatched on ambulance calls. Mr. Kevin Mahaney, 913 Piatt Avenue, questioned the payment of the Interim Fire Chief and other ambulance service previously interested in serving Mattoon. Administrator Gill noted the payment to the Interim Fire Chief was less than the previous chief's salary and benefits and replacement of other vacancies due to promotions, and with five different ambulance services in the past years discontinuing in Mattoon, an opportunity to allow Mitchell-Jerdan to operate was given. Council explained the moratorium of up to six months to determine the abilities of Mitchell-Jerdan to provide services. Ms. Angel Harrison, 913 Piatt Avenue, questioned the moratorium with Council clarifying the moratorium of up to six months. Mr. Jason Wright questioned the purpose of the moratorium and failing points. Council with Administrator Gill explained the performance, legal issues, and Mitchell-Jerdan meeting 95-96% of the response answer standards.

Mayor Gover declared the motion carried by the following vote; YEA Commissioner Cox, YEA Commissioner Graven, YEA Commissioner Hall, YEA Commissioner Owen, YEA Mayor Gover.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

CITY ADMINISTRATOR/COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT noted time spent on the budgets, negotiations and arbitration. Mayor Gover opened the floor for questions with no response.

Mayor Gover thanked the audience for attending and their discussion.

CITY ATTORNEY noted business as usual and a meeting with Judge Bovard to address the nuisance properties and juvenile issues. Mayor Gover opened the floor for questions with no response.

CITY CLERK noted business as usual and had 42 Early Voters in the Office. Mayor Gover opened the floor for questions with no response.

FINANCE distributed and reviewed the February Financial Report including the cash position, receipt of the franchise tax monies, and reduction of retiree health expenditures in February. Mayor Gover opened the floor for questions with no response.

PUBLIC WORKS updated the Council on powerwashing and tuckpointing of the Public Library, SCADA upgrades and clearwell construction at the Water Treatment Plant, crews repairing pot holes, Yardwaste facility preparing for Spring, and reminder of the Cleanup Day on the 3rd Saturday in May.

FIRE met with all crews, reported on calls, and was pleased to meet the Fire staff. Mayor Gover opened the floor for questions with no response.

POLICE reported officer levels are at the 1987 level with calls and arrests up, and have no personnel to lose. Mayor Gover opened the floor for questions with no response.

ARTS AND TOURISM noted a busy planning season; otherwise, business as usual. Mayor Gover opened the floor for questions with no response.

COMMENTS BY THE COUNCIL

Commissioner Cox noted there are disagreements with the Public, but Council has the best interest in mind. Commissioner Hall noted although the Council addresses difficult subjects, the Departments want to provide quality services with the funding they have while the taxpayers not wanting to pay more for better services; and Mattoon in Motion has a lot of good things in this area. Mayor Gover noted monthly meetings with Charleston's Mayor and Administrator as well as some Department Heads meet as well to cooperate between communities. Commissioners Graven and Owen had no further comments.

Mayor Gover seconded by Commissioner Hall moved to recess to closed session at 7:31 p.m. pursuant to the Illinois Open Meetings Act for the purpose of the discussion of collective negotiating matters between the City of Mattoon and its employees or their representatives, or deliberations concerning salary schedules for one or more classes of employees (5ILCS 120 (2)(C)(2)); and litigation that is affecting the City and an action is probable or imminent (5ILCS 120(2)(C)(11)).

Mayor Gover declared the motion carried by the following vote: YEA Commissioner Cox, YEA Commissioner Graven, YEA Commissioner Hall, YEA Commissioner Owen, YEA Mayor Gover.

Council reconvened at 7:44 p.m.

Council with Department Heads discussed the meeting, budget reductions and total deficit of just over \$509,000, overtime, revenues, video gaming, Cemetery excavator, and Walkers property.

Commissioner Hall seconded by Commissioner Owen moved to adjourn at 7:59 p.m.

WHEREAS, Amtrak is in the process of completing ADA accessibility improvements at their passenger stations across the United States; and

WHEREAS, Amtrak is preparing to begin construction of ADA accessibility improvements to the Train Depot at 1718 Broadway Avenue at no cost to the City of Mattoon; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mattoon owns and maintains a sanitary sewer under the east passenger platform of said Train Depot; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mattoon wishes to pay to have said sanitary sewer replaced as part of the ADA Accessibility Project; and

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions for the cost participation by the City of Mattoon are detailed in the Reimbursement Agreement attached as Exhibit 'Z'.

WHEREAS, a sketch showing the proposed reconstruction limits for said sanitary sewer is attached as Exhibit 'A'.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council for the City of Mattoon, Coles County, Illinois, that the Reimbursement Agreement with the National Railroad Passenger Corporation attached as Exhibit 'Z' be approved.

NATIONAL RAILROAD PASSENGER

CORPORATION REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT

Recitals:

In connection with its intercity passenger rail services and activities related thereto, Amtrak uses the railroad station located with the City of Mattoon, Illinois (the Station); and

Pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 U.S.C. §12101 *et. seq.*, as amended (the ADA), and the United States Department of Transportation regulations found at 49 CFR Part 37 (the DOT Regulations), intercity rail stations, including passenger platforms, designated waiting areas, ticketing areas, parking facilities/pathways and restrooms, are required to be made accessible to persons with disabilities; and

Amtrak has designed the required ADA improvements to the station and the City of Mattoon has agreed to pay for the replacement of the City's combined storm sewer located under the existing and proposed platform and which will be cost effective to install at the same time as the ADA improvements.

The Parties agree to work together in a cooperative manner to ensure that the improvements are made as quickly as reasonably possible.

The Parties agree as follows:

1. SCOPE OF WORK

The City of Mattoon has agreed to pay for the replacement of their combined storm sewer pipe, currently located under the existing platform, to be relocated under the proposed platform which is being installed as part of the ADA improvements, as shown in Exhibit A attached hereto. Any modifications to the scope of work shall require the written consent of both Parties, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, conditioned or delayed.

2. PERFORMANCE OF THE WORK

The Parties agree that Amtrak will arrange for the construction of the Improvements.

3. <u>FUNDING</u>

Combined Storm Sewer

The total estimated cost of the Improvements (Cost Estimate) is \$326,940.32 Dollars. Mattoon hereby agrees to fund the cost of the Improvements. To the extent that the actual cost incurred in making the Improvements exceed five percent (5%) of the Cost Estimate, Amtrak shall provide notice of such changes to Mattoon along with an explanation of the change in the Cost Estimate. Mattoon and Amtrak shall negotiate in good faith Mattoon's contribution to the cost of such overruns.

4. **REIMBURSEMENT**

Combined Storm Sewer

Mattoon hereby agrees to reimburse Amtrak for the costs of the Improvements. The cost of the Improvements shall be paid in accordance with the following procedure.

- a. Amtrak will initially fund the cost of the Improvements.
- b. Upon substantial completion of the Improvements, Amtrak shall invoice Mattoon for the costs incurred by Amtrak, and Mattoon shall pay Amtrak for such sums within ten (10) days of receipt of such invoice.

For purposes of this Agreement, the reimbursable amount must have been incurred by Amtrak, its contractors and/or subcontractors while acting in furtherance of Amtrak's duties as set forth in Section 2 hereof.

5. <u>AUDIT AND MAINTENANCE OF RECORDS</u>

- a. Amtrak will establish and maintain accurate records, in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, of all expenses incurred for which payment is sought or made under this Agreement ("Records"). Separate accounts will be established and maintained for all costs incurred under this Agreement.
- b. Amtrak will maintain the Records for at least one (1) year from the date of final payment made by Mattoon under this Agreement. In the event of a dispute with regard to the allowable expenses or any other issue under this Agreement, Amtrak will thereafter continue to maintain the Records at least until that dispute has been fully decided and the time for all available challenges or appeals of that decision has expired.
- c. Mattoon or its representatives may inspect, copy (subject to Section 6), scan, or audit the Records at any reasonable time after giving reasonable notice.
- d. If any part of the work is subcontracted, Amtrak will assure compliance with subsections (a), (b), and (c) above for all subcontracted work.

- e. In the event that an audit performed by or on behalf of Mattoon indicates an adjustment to the costs reported under the costs of this Agreement or questions the allowability of an item of expense, Mattoon will promptly submit to Amtrak a copy of the audit report, which may supplement or modify any tentative findings verbally communicated to Amtrak at the completion of an audit.
- f. Within sixty (60) days after receipt of the audit report, Amtrak will (i) respond in writing to Mattoon indicating whether or not it concurs with the audit report, (ii) clearly explain the nature and basis for any disagreement as to a disallowed item of expense, and (iii) submit to Mattoon a written explanation of any questioned or no opinion expressed item of expense ("Response"). The Response will be clearly stated and will provide any supporting documentation necessary to resolve any disagreement or questioned or no opinion expressed item of expense. Where the documentation is voluminous, Amtrak may supply appropriate excerpts and make alternate arrangements to conveniently and reasonably make that documentation available for review by Mattoon. The Response will refer to and apply the language of the Agreement. Amtrak agrees that failure to submit a Response within the sixty (60) day period constitutes agreement with any disallowance of an item of expense and authorizes Mattoon to finally disallow any items of questioned or no opinion expressed cost.
- g. If the Parties determine that an overpayment has been made to Amtrak, Amtrak will repay that amount to Mattoon or reach agreement with Mattoon on a repayment schedule within thirty (30) days after the date of an invoice from Mattoon. If the parties are unable to agree with respect to any alleged overpayment, either party hereto may submit the question to a Court of competent jurisdiction for determination.

6. <u>CONFIDENTIALITY</u>

If either party discloses its confidential information to the other party, the other party will maintain such information as confidential. Information provided by either party will be deemed confidential only if it is marked confidential. Mattoon further agrees not to disclose any confidential information to third parties. The above obligations confidentiality will not apply to the following:

- a. Information for which the disclosing party gives prior written permission for publication or use.
- b. Information that is required to be disclosed based on law, including the Freedom of Information Act, or court order, including subpoenas. Mattoon agrees that, in the event any confidential information of Amtrak is sought by subpoena or other process, Mattoon will promptly give notice of such subpoena or process to Amtrak, pursuant to the notification provisions herein, before responding to such subpoena or process.

A violation of this confidentiality provision will be considered a breach of this Agreement, and either party may terminate this Agreement in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. Upon completion or termination of this Agreement, or as otherwise requested by Amtrak, Mattoon will immediately return all such confidential information to Amtrak or make other disposition thereof as directed by Amtrak. This confidentiality section will survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement. Mattoon will not make any formal news releases relating to this Agreement without the prior approval of Amtrak.

7. NOTICES

Any notices required by this Agreement by either party will be in writing and will be directed to the officials identified herein electronically, by personal delivery, or by deposit in the United States mail, certified first class delivery. The representatives and/or addressees set forth herein may be changed at any time by either party by written notice to the other party.

The parties will comply with all applicable state, federal, and local laws and regulations in the performance of this Agreement.

9. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the Parties with respect to the subject matter thereof and supersedes all prior written and oral agreements and understandings with respect to such subject matter. This Agreement cannot be altered, modified, amended, waived, extended, changed, discharged or terminated orally or by any act on the part of either Party,

but only by an agreement in writing signed by the Party against whom enforcement of any alteration, modification, amendment, waiver, extension, change, discharge or termination is sought.

10. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>

If any part of this Agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, such determination will not affect the validity, legality, or enforceability of any other part of this Agreement, and the remaining parts of this Agreement will be enforced as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable part were not contained herein.

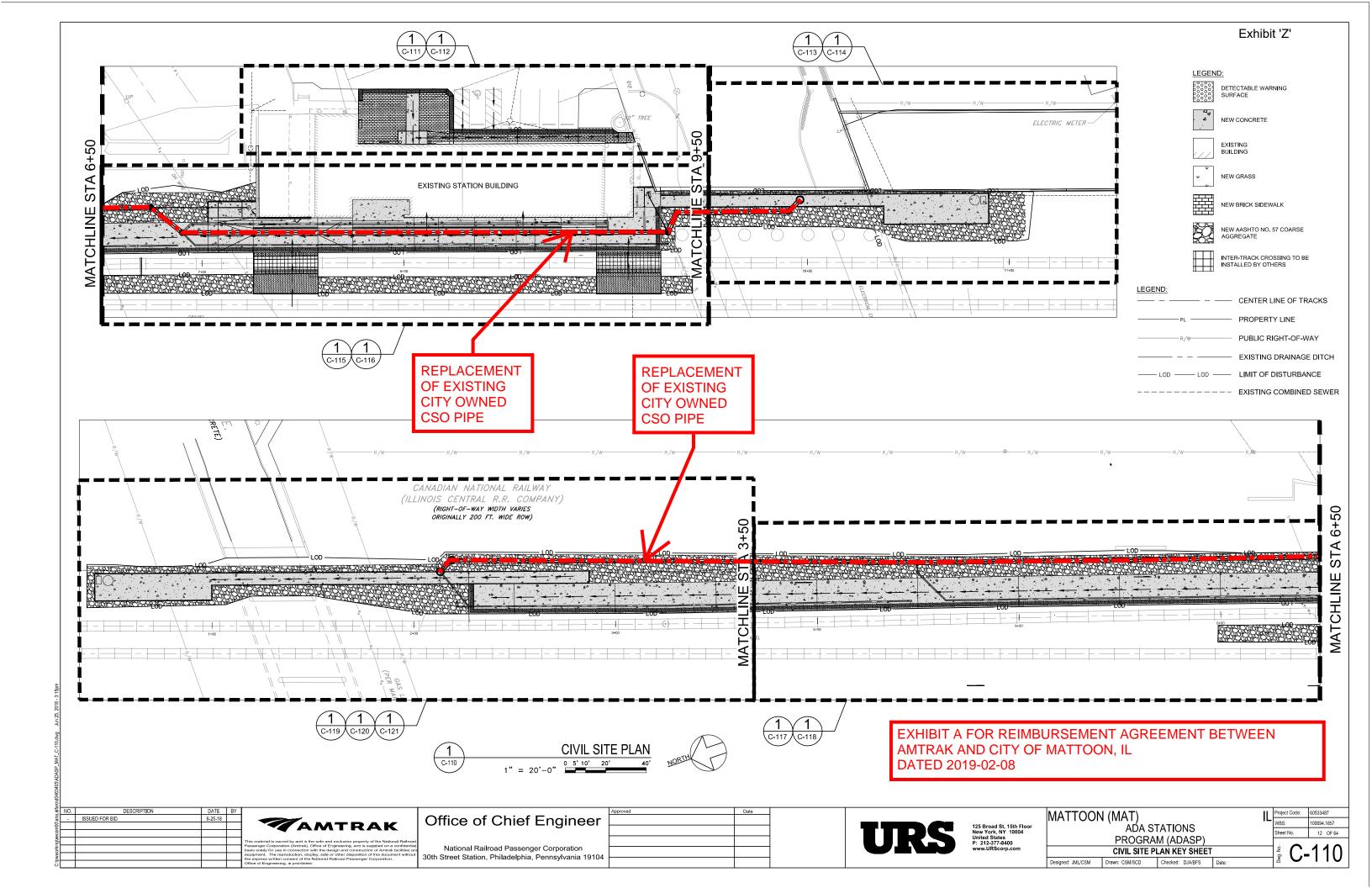

SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 2019-1704

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE FOR DRUG REHABILITATION FACILITY

WHEREAS, Teen Challenge Illinois is the prospective owner of the property commonly known as 3516 Powell Lane (legal description attached hereto). Teen Challenge has filed a Petition with the City Clerk's office of the City of Mattoon, requesting that said premises be granted a special use for the lawful right to operate a drug rehabilitation facility; and,

WHEREAS, said premises is zoned R3, Multi-Family which does not allow rehabilitation uses unless a special use is granted; and,

WHEREAS, upon examination of all of the facts and circumstances, the property is well suited for the operation of a Drug Rehabilitation Facility; and,

WHEREAS, the Petition for the Special Use was the subject of a public hearing before the Planning Commission for the City of Mattoon, Coles County, Illinois, and following that Public Hearing, the Plan Commission considered the facts and the relevant ordinances and thereafter recommended to the City Council that the requested special use permit be granted subject to certain specified conditions; and,

WHEREAS the City Council for the City of Mattoon, Coles County, Illinois, deems that it would be in the public interest to approve a special use permit to allow the operation of a drug rehabilitation facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MATTOON, COLES COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to enabling authority provided at Section §159.05 of the Mattoon Code of Ordinances, the property legally described as aforesaid, be and the same is granted a special use permit for lawful right to operate a Drug Rehabilitation Facility with the following conditions.

- **a.** The facility shall be a "locked down" facility, with security measures in place to mitigate the potential of a resident escape.
- **b.** The operations of the facility shall be managed by the operator so as not to create a nuisance factor or otherwise interfere with neighbors' enjoyment of their property.
- **c.** The physical plant, property and grounds, and operations of the facility shall be managed and maintained by the operator so as not have an adverse effect on the value of surrounding properties nor impede their proper development.
- **d.** The operations of the facility shall be managed by the operator so as to not make any loud or unusual noise as will disturb the peace and quiet of the surrounding neighborhood.
- **e.** The special use shall only be granted to operate a "phase 2" and above facility. A detoxification or "phase 1", rehabilitation facility is not granted under this ordinance.

- **f.** An inspection and evaluation of the property shall be made annually or at such time any written complaints are filed.
- **g.** The special use permit may be revoked for a specific period at the discretion of the City Council should there be a breach of any of the conditions of approval.
- **h.** The special use permit is not transferable without the consent of the City Council, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- i. This facility shall operate no more than 60 beds.
- **j.** This facility must meet all code, standards, and ordinances currently in place at time of passing.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the City Council.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective upon its approval as provided by law.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall make and file a duly certified copy of this ordinance with the Clerk and Recorder's Office of Coles County, Illinois.

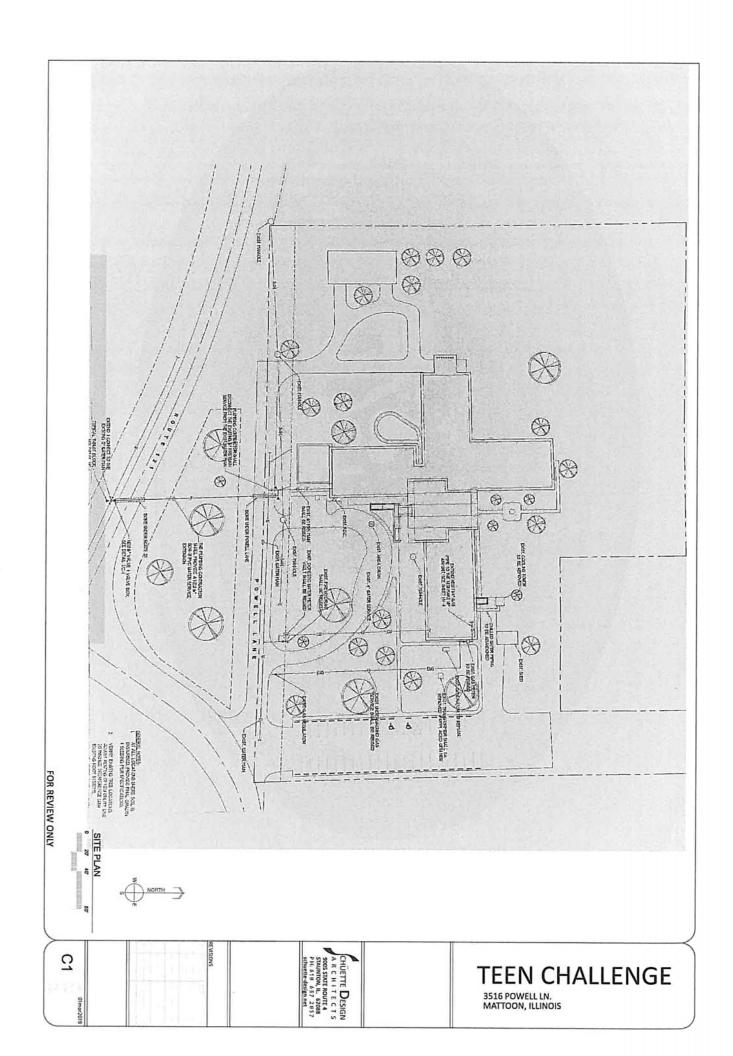

SUMMARY OF THE TOPIC FOR WHICH A COUNCIL DECISION IS REQUESTED:

The attached IDOT Change Order includes 2 items:

PCC Sidewalk, 5" \$11,587.80 Subbase Removal & Replacement \$25,407.48 Total \$36,995.28

Sidewalk - We relocated the water main on the north side of Marshall Avenue from 14th Street to 12th Street with in-house crews. The new water main was constructed under the existing sidewalk. Our crews removed the existing sidewalk, constructed the proposed water main and services, and eliminated the existing water main. Beniach Construction replaced the sidewalk as part of the roadway project. This cost is for the new sidewalk construction.

Subbase – The subgrade (soil) under the existing pavement on Marshall Avenue is very soft. It holds a lot of water and is very difficult to compact. We included 8" of aggregate subbase under the proposed pavement to support the roadway due to the soil conditions. The existing subgrade from 6th Street to 7th Street was even softer than the remainder of the project. We removed an additional 8" of subgrade in that area and replaced it with aggregate subbase. This is the cost to complete that work.

FRC00200 - The project includes 8" of aggregate subbase under the proposed pavement due to soft subgrade conditions. The subgrade was particularly soft from 9th Street to 10th Street. An additional 8" of the existing subgrade was removed and replaced with 2" aggregate to provide a stable platform for paving.

SUMMARY OF THE TOPIC FOR WHICH A COUNCIL DECISION IS REQUESTED:

Partridge, Inc. is a Commercial customer of the Water & Sewer Department and experienced a water leak that resulted in high water usage. The leak was repaired by the customer and proper documentation has been submitted for a billing adjustment. It is our policy to adjust two months of bills when the leak spans two billing cycles, as in this case. The amount of the adjustment for the February 2019 bill was calculated at \$2,848.23 and the amount of the adjustment for the March 2019 bill was calculated at \$1,943.21. As the amount of the adjustment exceeds \$1,000, formal approval is required by City Council. The adjustment will result in a loss of revenue to the Water and Sewer Funds.
