#### PRESENTATIONS, PETITIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS

#### **PUBLIC HEARING** –Coles Centre Site Plats

Mayor Gover opened the Public Hearing for the three site plans located in the Coles Centre Subdivision as follows: 100 Coles Centre Parkway (Hilton Garden Inn), 101 Coles Centre Drive (HSHS); 201 Coles Centre Parkway (BCBS) in the City Hall Council Chambers at 6:32 p.m. on September 17, 2019 as published in the Mattoon Journal Gazette on August 31, 2019. City Administrator Kyle Gill explained the locations, good neighbor setback and landscaping requirements which the properties met the requirements and had the approval from the Planning Commission and Corridor Review Committee including Mattoon, Charleston and Airport Authority. Administrator Gill further reviewed the variance with the height limits and encroachment further meeting the Airport Authority requirements. Mayor Gover opened the floor for questions or comments. Commissioner Cox commented on the landscape change and great project. Mayor Gover added the potential for other developments in the planning stage to follow. With no further comments or questions from the Public, Mayor Gover closed the Public Hearing at 6:36 p.m.

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2019-5422**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY'S PRIVATE MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION; AMBULANCE CODE

WHEREAS, the City of Mattoon on March 19, 2019 passed a Temporary Moratorium on the issuance of any Ambulance Service Licenses; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mattoon's Temporary Moratorium will expire on September 20, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mattoon has determined the following amendment should be made to the Private Medical Transportation; Ambulance Code.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MATTOON, ILLINOIS;

**Section 1. Recitals.** The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

**Section 2. Amendments.** Section 34.091 of Chapter 34 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mattoon is hereby amended.

The total number of Ambulance Service Licenses available to be issued within the City of Mattoon shall be limited to two (2) one (1). The number of licenses shall be reviewed annually by the City Council, and the number of licenses may be increased or decreased by the City Council during such review. Prior to the annual review by the City Council, for each existing license holder, the Fire Chief shall review Emergency Response Business Records, written Reports of Response Time Performance as required by this Chapter, Monthly Performance Data Reports as required by this Chapter, and all other documents of any kind related to a license holder's responses to emergency calls, including any data on total number of calls and the number of calls out of town ambulance services have responded to within the City limits and any other documents deemed necessary to make a report and recommendation to the City Council regarding the number of licenses.

The license holder shall make its best effort to provide all such information listed in section 34.091 to the Fire Chief within seven (7) days of the Fire Chief's written request. The failure of a license holder to provide such information to the Fire Chief, the withholding of any portion of such information from the Fire Chief, or the providing of false or inaccurate information to the Fire Chief shall serve as the basis for the potential fines, suspension or revocation of the license

by the Ambulance Review Committee pursuant to Section 34.113 of this Chapter, or by the City Council at the annual review.

The Fire Chief shall review the information provided, and make a report as to whether each license holder is following the Rules of Emergency Dispatch promulgated by this Ordinance, following the provisions of this Chapter, and providing timely and appropriate emergency care to the Citizens of Mattoon. The Fire Chief shall provide this report to the City Council prior to the annual review, along with any recommendations he or she may have relating to the increase or decrease in the number of licenses. The Fire Chief may use the information discovered during this review to recommend to fine, suspend or revoke the license of an existing license holder, pursuant to the provisions of Section 34.113 of this Chapter.

Ambulance Service license required; exceptions.

- (a) Unless a license is specifically not required by this section, no person either as owner, agent, or otherwise shall furnish, operate, conduct, maintain, advertise, or otherwise engage in ambulance service in the City of Mattoon without a current ambulance service license issued pursuant to this chapter by the city or in violation of the terms or conditions of the license.
- (b) No ambulance license is required by:
  - (1) An ambulance service which has no maintenance, dispatch or storage facilities in the City of Mattoon and which does not respond to an emergency within the city; or
  - (2) An ambulance service authorized by mutual aid or in accordance with section 34.112.
- (c) In the event the ambulance service operates within the city without a license, the city may issue a notice of violation and a fine in the minimum amount of \$250.00 and no more than the general penalty of § 10.99, in the City of Mattoon Code of Ordinances, upon conviction.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its publication and approval as provided by law. The Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

## SUMMARY OF THE TOPIC FOR WHICH A COUNCIL DECISION IS REQUESTED:

Lt. J.D. McCain retired on August 01, 2019.

Police Officer staffing has now dropped to levels last seen in the 1970's, while demand for police services has tripled since that decade. In order to appropriately staff the Department and police the City, it is the recommendation of Chief Jason Taylor that the number of police officers on the roster be returned to forty-two (42), the same number of officers which were on the roster in the 1990's. The hiring of Michael Bennett will only bring staffing up to thirty-six (36) sworn officers.

The Mattoon Board of Fire and Police Commissioners have advised that Michael H. Bennett is the next qualified candidate on the current experienced officer list. In June, 2017 Mr. Bennett completed the necessary training through the Police Training Institute in Champaign as a Law Enforcement Officer and is certified by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board. Mr. Bennett would begin the FTO (Field Training Officer) program immediately.

Upon full execution thereof, the Grant Agreement shall be attached to this ordinance as EXHIBIT "A".

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the City Council.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall be effective upon its approval as provided by law.

## **GRANT AGREEMENT**

(hereinafter the "Grantor"), and	Rural King Realty	L.L.C., owner of re	al estate located at 700
Broadway Avenue East, Mattoon,	, Coles County, Illir	nois, (hereinafter the	"Grantee"), as follows:

- 1. Grantor does grant unto Grantee up to the sum of Three Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$323,133.00) to be disbursed as hereinafter described, subject to the following terms and conditions:
  - A. It is agreed and understood that said grant shall be for the sole purpose of making site improvements including drainage, lighting and landscaping modifications to the property located at 700 Broadway Avenue East, Mattoon, Coles County, Illinois. This grant is specifically contingent upon the undersigned first receiving initial design approval from the City. The undersigned acknowledges that the primary consideration for the grant herein from the City of Mattoon unto the undersigned is to achieve an improvement for the City, and, as such, the undersigned acknowledges this consideration and agrees to abide by the rules and regulations and oversight of the City of Mattoon for implementation and/or construction of said design including, but not necessarily limited to: construction of said design pursuant to the design specifications; prior consent from the City of Mattoon before any alterations or changes to the design; oversight authority on the part of the City of Mattoon during the construction of said design if reasonably necessary to ensure said design and specifications are being complied with. Further, as additional consideration herein, the undersigned covenants that once completed, said City-approved improvement work shall remain the same and not be substantially changed without prior written consent of the City within 10 years of completion of the same, which covenant shall survive the payment of the grant and remain obligatory unto the parties herein whether or not they retain control of the property or transfer the same to a third party within said 10 years. Should the undersigned sell or convey all or a part of said property, it guarantees and promises unto the City of Mattoon that it shall include in the deed of conveyance a restriction on changing said improvements for said 10-year period. Said prohibition upon a substantial alteration of said improvements do not prohibit the undersigned from periodic and regular maintenance of the same. The undersigned agrees to commence the improvements within 120 days of initial design approval from the City, and to proceed

diligently to the completion of the same, but in no event to be completed in not less than 12 months from the date hereof. During said construction, the City, at any time, can issue a written notice to the undersigned that it is in violation of the agreed upon design and specifications heretofore approved by the City. The undersigned will have thirty (30) days from receipt of written notice of noncompliance with design to correct the same to the City's satisfaction or otherwise reach a mutually agreeable resolution of the same. If correction or a mutual resolution is not completed within said thirty (30) day response time, then in that event, the City may consider this grant to be in default, to cease all future payments due hereunder, and shall rescind the grant. Accordingly, the undersigned hereby agrees to assume all responsibility for any damages or claims for damages as a result of any injuries or claims for injuries for said improvements, and, further, agrees to indemnify and hold the City of Mattoon free and harmless in association with any damages or claims for damages by the undersigned, or other third parties.

- B. It is agreed and understood that the grant shall be for the purpose of improvements at 700 Broadway Avenue East, Mattoon, Coles County, Illinois.
- C. It is agreed and understood that there is dollar limit flexibility between the elements of construction cost as more fully set forth hereinabove. Said grant proceeds shall be based upon the actual construction cost of work, but not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$323,133.00) as determined by the City's authorized agent.
- D. Grantee shall secure the necessary building permits from Grantor, and shall indemnify and hold the Grantor harmless from any and all claims, damages, and injuries associated with or resulting from the improvement of said real estate.
- E. It is agreed and understood that improvement of said real estate shall include improvements of 700 Broadway Avenue East. Grantee warrants that the total value of the improvements at 700 Broadway Avenue East shall not be less than Four Hundred Thirty Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Four Dollars (\$430,844.00), including the grant authorized by this agreement.

- F. Any and all work performed under this grant shall be at the prevailing wage in Coles County and as adopted by the City of Mattoon from time to time. Grantee hereby agrees to abide by all the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130 et.seq.
- 2. Grantor shall disburse the grant funds to Grantee in six total payments. The initial payment in the amount of \$178,133.00 shall be made following the completion of all the improvements. Thereafter annual payments of up to \$29,000.00 per year shall be paid on each September 1<sup>st</sup> until the balance is paid. The payments shall only be made if this grant is valid and in full force at the time the payment is to be made.
- 3. This Grant is expressly contingent upon the execution of this grant agreement by Grantee and Grantor and upon presentation to Grantor of vouchers or other sufficient proof of work authorized and approved and within the scope of this grant in amounts which exceed the grant money provided herein.
- 4. Grantee does hereby guarantee and covenant that it will apply the grant money only for the uses intended as set forth herein pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein.
- 5. Grantor's grant as made herein is made contingent upon Grantee performing all of the covenants and conditions by it to be performed.
- 6. This is an outright grant and is not repayable to Grantor unless Grantee fails to perform one or more of the covenants and conditions herein by it to be performed, and in that event, Grantor shall send written notice of said breach to Grantee and afford it an opportunity to correct the same within 30 days. Should Grantee fail to correct the breach within 30 days of said written notice, then in that event, Grantor shall rescind the grant and shall be entitled to recover from Grantee any and all grant moneys heretofore delivered to Grantee, which grant money Grantee agrees to repay unto Grantor.
- 7. This grant made herein is duly adopted by the City Council of the City of Mattoon meeting in regular session on October 1, 2019.
- 8. Grantee covenants unto Grantor that it intends to retain ownership of the property for the operation of a commercial business or businesses, and that it is not its intention to use the grant money herein to remodel the property and then resell the same to a third party. To secure this

covenant, Grantor and Grantee agree that if the property is sold to a third party, then there shall be a rebate of the grant based upon the following schedule: if sold within one year of the date of the grant, the grant shall be null and void and there shall be a 75% rebate of the grant amount already paid; if sold after one year from the date of this grant but within two years of the date of this grant, the grant shall be null and void and then there shall be a 50% rebate of the grant amount already paid; and if sold after two years from the date of this grant but within three years of the date of this grant, the grant shall be null and void and then there shall be a 25% rebate of the grant amount already paid.

- 9. Grantee shall provide (or cause to be provided) written notice to the City prior to taking any action contesting the assessed value of any or all the property located at 700 Broadway Avenue East.
- 10. This grant is subject to the availability of Broadway East TIF District Funds.
- 11. Grantor reserves to itself the right to seek reimbursement for the amount expended under this grant from revenues of the Mattoon Broadway East Tax Increment Financing District.

## **GRANT AGREEMENT**

This Grant Agreement is made this \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, 2019, by and between the CITY OF MATTOON, Coles County, Illinois, a municipal corporation (hereinafter the "Grantor"), and COLES CENTRE L.L.C. owner of LOT 7 in COLES CENTRE SUBDIVISION PHASE II, Mattoon, Coles County, Illinois, (hereinafter together referred to as the "Grantee"), as follows:

1. Grantor does grant unto Grantee up to the sum of Seven Hundred Seventeen Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Seven Dollars (\$717,197.00) to be disbursed as hereinafter described, subject to the following terms and conditions:

A. It is agreed and understood that the grant shall be for the sole purpose of engineering for, construction and inspection of streets, lighting and sidewalks around LOT 7 in COLES CENTRE SUBDIVISION PHASE II, Mattoon, Coles County, Illinois. Said construction shall be pursuant to a design which first must be acceptable to the City of Mattoon. The authorized agent acting on behalf of the City is the City Administrator or such other official the City Council may designate. Said construction must include, but is not necessarily limited to a list of specifications such as material type, colors, and construction methods. Since this is an economic development project, the City of Mattoon reserves the right to demand a high level of detail concerning design, materials, colors and other construction aspects, and, further, demands strict adherence to said construction. This grant is specifically contingent upon the undersigned first receiving initial design approval from the City. The undersigned acknowledges that the primary consideration for the grant herein from the City of Mattoon unto the undersigned is to achieve an economic development program for the City, and, as such, the undersigned acknowledges this consideration and agrees to abide by the rules and regulations and oversight of the City of Mattoon for implementation and/or construction of said economic development including, but not necessarily limited to: completion of said engineering and construction pursuant to the design specifications; prior consent from the City of Mattoon before any alterations or changes to the design; oversight authority on the part of the City of Mattoon during the construction of said streets, lighting and sidewalks if reasonably necessary to ensure said design and specifications are being complied with. Further, as additional consideration herein, the undersigned covenants that once completed, said City-approved improvement work shall remain the same and not be substantially changed without prior written consent of the City within 10 years of completion of the same, which covenant shall survive the payment of the grant and remain obligatory unto the parties herein whether or not they retain control of the property or transfer the same to a third party within said 10 years. Should the undersigned sell or convey all or a part of said property, it guarantees and promises unto the City of Mattoon that it shall include in the deed of conveyance a restriction on changing said improvements for said 10-year period. Said prohibition upon a substantial alteration of said improvements do not prohibit the undersigned from periodic and regular maintenance of the same. The undersigned agrees to commence the improvements within 180 days of initial design approval from the City, and to proceed diligently to the completion of the same, but in no event to be completed in not less than 18 months from the date hereof. During said construction, the City, at any time, can issue a written notice to the undersigned that it is in violation of the agreed upon design and specifications heretofore approved by the City. The undersigned will

have thirty (30) days from receipt of written notice of noncompliance with design to correct the same to the City's satisfaction or otherwise reach a mutually agreeable resolution of the same. If correction or a mutual resolution is not completed within said thirty (30) day response time, then in that event, the City may consider this grant to be in default, to cease all future payments due hereunder, and shall rescind the grant. Accordingly, the undersigned hereby agrees to assume all responsibility for any damages or claims for damages as a result of any injuries or claims for injuries from said improvements, and, further, agrees to indemnify and hold the City of Mattoon free and harmless in association with any damages or claims for damages by the undersigned, or other third parties.

- B. It is agreed and understood that the grant shall be for the purpose of engineering for and construction and inspection of streets, lighting and sidewalks around LOT 7 in COLES CENTRE SUBDIVISION PHASE II, in conjunction with the development of LOT 7 in COLES CENTRE SUBDIVISION PHASE II for the benefit of Health Care Service Corporation d.b.a. BlueCross BlueShield of Illinois, Inc., Mattoon, Coles County, Illinois.
- C. It is agreed and understood that there is dollar limit flexibility between the elements of engineering and construction cost as more fully set forth hereinabove. Said grant proceeds shall be based upon the actual engineering and construction costs incurred, but not to exceed Seven Hundred Seventeen Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Seven Dollars (\$717,197.00) as determined by the City's authorized agent.
- D. Grantee shall secure the necessary permits from Grantor, and shall indemnify and hold the Grantor harmless from any and all claims, damages, and injuries associated with or resulting from the construction improvements of said real estate.
- E. It is agreed and understood this grant for public improvements to said real estate shall be contingent upon receipt of full grant funding from CDBG and EDP. Further the Grantee warrants a total public improvement value of Two Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-Six Dollars (\$2,250,476.00) and a total building construction value of Thirteen Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$13,800,000.00) for use by HCSC.
- F. Any and all work performed under this grant shall be at the prevailing wage in Coles County and as adopted by the City of Mattoon from time to time. Grantee hereby agrees to abide by all the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130 et.seq.
- 2. Grantor shall disburse the grant funds to Grantee in Six (6) annual payments. These payments shall begin on September 30 in the year following both completion of the all improvements, including the construction of a new building for the benefit of Health Care Service Corporation d.b.a. BlueCross BlueShield of Illinois, and the reassessment of the property. The amount of these payments shall be no more than One Hundred Nineteen Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$119,533.00) or one sixth of the actual construction cost and engineering fees for the work authorized within the scope of this grant, whichever is less, as certified by the City's authorized agent. The payments shall only be made if this grant is valid and in full force at the time the payments are to be made.

- 3. This Grant is expressly contingent upon the execution of this grant agreement by Grantee and Grantor and upon presentation to Grantor of vouchers or other sufficient proof of work authorized and approved and within the scope of this grant in amounts which exceed the grant money provided herein.
- 4. Grantee does hereby guarantee and covenant that it will apply the grant money only for the uses intended as set forth herein pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein.
- 5. Grantor's grant as made herein is made contingent upon Grantee performing all of the covenants and conditions by it to be performed.
- 6. This is an outright grant and is not repayable to Grantor unless Grantee fail to perform one or more of the covenants and conditions herein by it to be performed, and in that event, Grantor shall send written notice of said breach to Grantee and afford it an opportunity to correct the same within 30 days. Should Grantee fail to correct the breach within 30 days of said written notice, then in that event, Grantor shall rescind the grant, and shall be entitled to recover from Grantee any and all grant moneys heretofore delivered to Grantee, which grant money Grantee agrees to repay unto Grantor.
- 7. This grant made herein is duly adopted by the City Council of the City of Mattoon meeting in regular session on October 01, 2019.
- 8. This grant is subject to the availability of Interstate 57 TIF District Funds.
- 9. Grantor reserves to itself the right to seek reimbursement for the amount expended under this grant from revenues of the Interstate 57 Tax Increment Financing District.

# PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made as of the \_\_\_\_\_ day of October, 2019 by and between the City of Mattoon ("Unit of Local Government") and Health Care Service Corporation d/b/a BlueCross BlueShield of Illinois, Inc., an Illinois Mutual Legal Reserve Company ("Company").

**WHEREAS**, the Unit of Local Government is interested in expanding its economic base with the primary emphasis on creating and retaining jobs primarily for low and moderate-income persons; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit of Local Government has entered into an agreement with the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity to implement an economic development program that significantly impacts upon the Unit of Local Government's economic base; and

**WHEREAS**, the Company is interested in maintaining and/or expanding its employment base; and

**WHEREAS**, the Company is unable to maintain and/or expand its employment base unless and until certain public improvements are constructed by the Unit of Local Government;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

## I. GENERAL DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 <u>"Application"</u> shall mean all materials submitted by the Company to the Unit of Local Government or the State of Illinois in connection with this Agreement.
- 1.2 <u>"Company Contribution"</u> shall mean the contribution that the Company shall make in connection with the Agreement, as fully described in <u>Exhibit C</u>, attached hereto, and made a part hereof.
- 1.3 "DCEO Funds" shall mean the sum of \$480,000 representing the grant received by the Unit of Local Government pursuant to its agreement with the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO).
- 1.4 <u>"Project"</u> shall mean the public improvements to be constructed by the Unit of Local Government as fully described in <u>Exhibit A</u>, attached hereto and made a part thereof.
- 1.5 "Required Economic Results" shall mean those economic benefits and/or goals which the Company agrees to achieve as fully described in Exhibit B, attached hereto and made a part thereof.

#### II. PERFORMANCE

2.1 The Unit of Local Government agrees, subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, to construct the Project.

- 2.2 The project cost shall be paid with:
  - (a) DCEO funds,
  - (b) Other Unit of Local Government funds, if necessary,
  - (c) The Company Contribution, if so agreed in Exhibit C,

All as described in the Budget contained in Exhibit D, attached hereto and made a part thereof.

- 2.3 In the event the Unit of Local Government fails to receive the DCEO funds, for any reason, this Agreement shall be terminated, at the sole option of the Unit of Local Government, without fault as to either party.
- 2.4 The Company agrees to provide the Company Contribution as provided in Exhibit C.
- 2.5 The Company agrees to achieve the required economic results as provided in Exhibit B.

## III. COVENANTS, REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES OF THE COMPANY

- 3.1 On or prior to the date of this Agreement, the Unit of Local Government shall have received a certified copy of the Company's Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws or Partnership Certificate and Partnership Agreement, as the case may be, evidence of Company's good standing and resolutions of the Board of Directors or the general partner of the Company, as the case may be, authorizing this Agreement and such additional supporting documents as the Unit of Local Government may request.
- 3.2 On or prior to the date of this Agreement, all legal matters incident to this Agreement and the transactions contemplated hereby shall be satisfactory to the Unit of Local Government.
  - 3.3 Company represents and warrants that:
    - (a) Company is a corporation or partnership, as the case may be, duly formed, validly existing and in good standing under the laws of Illinois, is duly licensed and duly qualified as a foreign corporation or partnership, as the case may be, in good standing in all the jurisdictions in which the character of the property owned or leased or the nature of the business conducted by it requires such licensing or qualification and has all corporate or partnership powers, as the case may be, and all material governmental licenses, authorizations, consents and approvals required to carry on its business as now conducted.
    - (b) The execution, delivery and performance by Company of this Agreement, are within Company's corporate or partnership powers, have been duly authorized by all necessary corporate or partnership action, require no action by or in respect of, or filing with, any governmental body, agency or official and do not contravene any provision of applicable law or regulation or of the Articles of Incorporation or By-Laws or Partnership Agreement of Company, as the case may be.
    - (c) This Agreement constitutes a valid and binding agreement of Company.

- (d) The Application is in all respects true and accurate and there are no omissions or other facts or circumstances which may be material to this Agreement or the Project.
- (e) The financial statements delivered to Unit of Local Government pursuant to the Application fully and accurately present the financial condition of the Company. No material adverse change in the condition, financial or otherwise, of Company has occurred since the date of the financial statements most recently delivered to the Unit of Local Government.
- (f) Neither Company nor, to the best of Company's knowledge, any of Company's employees have been convicted of bribing or attempting to bribe an officer or employee of the Unit of Local Government, nor has the Company made an admission of guilt of such conduct which is a matter of record.
- (g) The company hereby certifies that neither it, nor any of its subsidiaries, has plans to relocate jobs at the time this Agreement is signed that would result in a significant job loss as defined in PROHIBITION ON USE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ASSISTANCE FOR JOBPIRATING ACTIVITIES; Interim rule contained in Federal Register: December 23, 2005 (Volume 70, Number 246).
- 3.4 The company shall keep detailed records of all matters related to this Agreement (including the Exhibits hereto).
- 3.5 The company shall comply with all applicable state and federal law and regulations promulgated thereunder. Company shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, sex, religion, national origin, age or handicap, including but not limited to the Illinois Human Rights Act, as now or hereafter amended, and the Equal Employment Opportunity Clause promulgated pursuant thereto.
- 3.6 Company shall fully and completely indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Unit of Local Government and the State of Illinois and their officers, directors, employees and agents against any liability, judgment, loss, cost, claim, damage (including consequential damage) or expense (including attorney's fees and disbursements, settlement costs, consultant fees, investigation and laboratory fees) to which any of them may become subject insofar as they may arise out of or are based upon this Agreement or any agreement or document executed by Company and Unit of Local Government as part of the transaction described herein.
- 3.7 The Unit of Local Government shall have the right of access, at all reasonable hours, to Company's premises and books and records for purpose of determining compliance with this Agreement. In addition to the reporting specifically required hereunder, Company shall furnish to the Unit of Local Government such information as the Unit of Local Government may reasonably request with respect to this Agreement.

# IV. DEFAULT AND REMEDIES

4.1 If one or more of the following events ("Defaults") occurs and is not timely cured, then, the Unit of Local Government may declare Company in default under this Agreement and seek any of the enumerated remedies described in this Section.

- (a) Company fails to observe or perform any covenant or agreement contained in this Agreement, including the Exhibits hereto, for 10 days after written notice to cure thereof has been given to Company by the Unit of Local Government;
- (b) Any representation, warranty, certificate or statement made by Company in this Agreement, including the Exhibits hereto, or in any certificate, report, financial statement or other document delivered pursuant to this Agreement shall prove to have been incorrect when made in any material respect;
- (c) Company shall commence a voluntary case or other proceeding seeking liquidation, reorganization or other relief with respect to itself or its debts under any bankruptcy, insolvency or other similar law now or hereafter in effect or seeking the appointment of a trustee, receiver, liquidator, custodian or other similar official of it or any substantial part of its property, or shall consent to any such relief or to the appointment of or taking possession by any such official in an involuntary case or other proceeding commenced against it, or shall make a general assignment for the benefit of creditors, or shall fail generally to pay its debts as they become due, or shall take any corporate action to authorize any of the foregoing;
- (d) An involuntary case or other proceeding shall be commenced against Company seeking liquidation, reorganization or other relief with respect to it or its debts under any bankruptcy, insolvency or other similar law now or hereafter in effect or seeking the appointment of a trustee, receiver, liquidator, custodian or other similar official of it or any substantial part of its property, and such involuntary case or other proceedings shall remain undismissed and unstayed for a period of 60 days; or an order for relief shall be entered against Company under the federal bankruptcy laws as now or hereafter in effect;
- (e) Company ceases the conduct of active trade or business in the Unit of Local Government's community for any reason, including, but not limited to, fire or other casualty;
- (f) Company fails to achieve the required economic results identified in <u>Exhibit</u> B;
- (g) Company fails to provide the Company Contribution as identified in <u>Exhibit</u> <u>C</u>;
- (h) Company, or any of its subsidiaries, relocates jobs within three years of the date of this Agreement that violates the PROHIBITION ON USE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ASSISTANCE FOR JOBPIRATING ACTIVITIES; Interim rule contained in Federal Register: December 23, 2005 (Volume 70, Number 246).
- 4.2 If a Default occurs and is not timely cured, then the Unit of Local Government shall seek reimbursement from the Company for all funds (including DCEO funds) expended by the Unit of Local Government on or related to the Project, including, but not limited to architectural engineering, construction, administrative, real estate and incidental costs related thereto.

- 4.3 Upon notice of a Default and if said Default is not timely cured, the Unit of Local Government shall notify the Company that reimbursement shall be made to the Unit of Local Government within 30 days after said notice. If the Company fails to reimburse the Unit of Local Government within 30 days after the date of the notice, the Unit of Local Government shall have the right to collect interest on the unpaid balance beginning on the 31<sup>st</sup> day after notice at a rate equal to 12% per annum.
- 4.4 If the Unit of Local Government is successful in any proceeding to enforce the terms of this Agreement, then the Unit of Local Government shall have the right to obtain from the Company, as an additional remedy, attorney fees, costs and expenses, related to the proceeding.

# V. TERMINATION

- 5.1 This Agreement may be terminated at any time by written, mutual agreement of the parties, provided the Unit of Local Government has obtained written consent from the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity as to such termination.
- 5.2 This Agreement may be terminated by the Unit of Local Government whenever it issues a notice of Default to the Company and the Company does not timely cure the Default pursuant to Section IV.
- 5.3 This Agreement will terminate when the Project has been completed and when all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement (including the Exhibits thereto) creating duties upon the Company, have been satisfied by the Company.

## VI. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 6.1 Notice required hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have validly served, given or delivered upon deposit in the United States mail, by registered mail, return receipt requested, at the address set forth on the signature page hereof or to such other address as each party may specify for itself by like notice.
- 6.2 All covenants, agreements, representations and warranties made herein and in the certificates delivered pursuant hereto shall survive the execution of the Agreement and shall continue in full force and effect so long as the Agreement shall be in force.
- 6.3 No failure or delay by the Unit of Local Government in exercising any right, power or privilege hereunder shall operate as a waiver thereof nor shall any single or partial exercise thereof preclude any other or further exercise thereof or the exercise of any other right, power or privilege. The rights and remedies herein provided shall be cumulative and not exclusive of any rights or remedies provided by law.
- 6.4 Wherever possible each provision of this Agreement shall be interpreted in such manner as to be effective and valid under applicable law, but if any provision shall be invalid under applicable law, such provision shall be ineffective to the extent of such invalidity without invalidating the remaining provisions of this Agreement.
- 6.5 This Agreement represents the full and complete agreement between the parties with respect to the matters addressed herein and there are no oral agreements or understandings between the parties.

- 6.6 This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the law of the State of Illinois.
- 6.7 This Agreement may be signed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be an original, with the same effect as if the signatures thereto and hereto were upon the same instrument.
- 6.8 No modification of or waiver of any provision of this Agreement shall be effective unless the same shall be in writing and signed by the parties hereto, and provided further, that the Unit of Local Government shall obtain written consent of the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity prior to executing any such modification or waiver.
- 6.9 The Company certifies that it has not been barred from bidding on or receiving State contracts as a result of a violation of Section 33E-3 or 33E-4 of the Criminal Code of 1961 (bid rigging or bid rotating, respectively) (720 ILCS 5/33E-3 and 5/33-4).
- 6.10 The Company certifies that it has not been barred from being awarded a contract or subcontract under Section 50-5 of the Illinois Procurement (Code 30 ILCS 500).
- 6.11 The Company acknowledges that receipt of benefits under this agreement may require compliance with the Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130). Persons willfully failing to comply with or violating this act may be in violation of the Criminal Code. Questions concerning compliance with the Prevailing Wage Act should be directed to the Illinois Department of Labor.
- 6.12 The Unit of Local Government acknowledges that if the project as proposed by this Agreement is completed in accordance with this Agreement and the Agreement executed between the Unit of Local Government and the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity then the provisions cited above in 6.9; 6.10; and 6.11 do not apply to the Company but do apply to the activities to be completed by the Unit of Local Government.

The benefit to low and moderate-income persons will be 51% for all additional employees hired. This will be documented through the use of the Employee Income Certification.

# LOCAL AGENCY/COMPANY AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made as of the \_\_\_\_\_ day of October, 2019 by and between the City of Mattoon, County of Coles, Illinois hereinafter called the LOCAL AGENCY and Health Care Service Corporation d.b.a. Blue Cross Blue Shield of Illinois, hereinafter called the COMPANY.

WHEREAS, the LOCAL AGENCY is interested in expanding its economic base with the primary emphasis on creating and retaining jobs; and

WHEREAS, the LOCAL AGENCY will enter into an agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the STATE, to implement an economic development program that significantly impacts upon the LOCAL AGENCY's economic base; and

WHEREAS, the COMPANY has proposed a project in the Coles Centre Subdivision, Mattoon Illinois, that will create and/or retain jobs, thus providing a significant benefit to the LOCAL AGENCY's economic base; and

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

# 1. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- 1.1. As required by Public Act 93-552, the COMPANY is required to submit to the STATE an annual progress report of employment for five years from the date of the IDOT/Local Agency funding agreement.
- 1.2. The annual progress report shall consist of job classifications, wages, number of positions, and other pertinent information.
- 1.3. All annual employee progress reports will be completed on-line through the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity. The COMPANY will be notified by letter annually with instructions on how and when to fill out their annual report. This report will then be submitted electronically to IDOT.

# 2. DEFAULT AND REMEDIES

- 2.1. The COMPANY shall make the investment in the Project which shall create approximately 50 full-time jobs at the facility on or before the first quarter of 2023.
- 2.2. Should COMPANY plans change or projects not get approved then the creation of jobs data supplied is not binding and the LOCAL AGENCY, as grant recipient, will inform the IDOT-Economic Development Program Coordinator.
- 2.3. In the event the COMPANY fails to create the required number of new full-time jobs, the COMPANY shall be required to repay the EDP funds to the LOCAL AGENCY. Repayment of the EDP funds shall be based on an amount calculated on a pro-rata basis, reflecting the percentage of deficiency between the required number of created full-time jobs and the actual number of created jobs at the aforementioned location.

## 3. TERMINATION

- 3.1. This Agreement may be terminated at any time by written, mutual agreement of the parties.
- 3.2. This Agreement, and all further obligations of the parties hereunder, will terminate when the Project has been completed and when the COMPANY has satisfied its reporting obligations under Section 1.

# 4. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 4.1. Wherever possible each provision of this Agreement shall be interpreted in such manner as to be effective and valid under applicable law, but if any provision shall be invalid under applicable law, such provision shall be ineffective to the extent of such invalidity without invalidating the remaining provisions of the Agreement.
- 4.2. This Agreement represents, the full and complete agreement between the parties with respect to the matters addressed herein and there are no oral agreements or understandings between the parties.
- 4.3. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the law of the State of Illinois.
