DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

State of Illinois County of Coles City of Mattoon

Pursuant to the authority vested in the office of Mayor by the Illinois Municipal Code Section 5/11-1-6, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act Section 3305/11 and Ordinance No. 2020-5430 of the City of Mattoon, I, Rick Hall, Mayor of the City of Mattoon do hereby declare that a Local State of Emergency exists as of this date, February 7, 2023, and shall continue until such time as provided in Ordinance No. 2020-5430.

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2020, the World Health Organization declared the outbreak of COVID-19 to be a public health emergency of international concern and on March 11, 2020 declared a worldwide pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the U.S. Health and Human Services Secretary declared a public health emergency for the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Illinois has issued a disaster proclamation on March 9, 2020 due to the impact of the COVID-19 virus and has activated the State Emergency Operations Center; and

WHEREAS, the State Emergency Management Agency has declared a public health emergency due to the impact of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration has coordinated its response with other Coles County governmental entities.

The nature of the emergency is related to the COVID-19 virus which is causing or anticipated to cause widespread impacts on the health of members of the community.

During the existence of the Local State of Emergency, the Mayor shall execute such authority as provided under the Illinois Municipal Code, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act and Ordinance No. 2020-5430.

This Declaration of Local State of Emergency shall be filed with the City Clerk as soon as practicable.

I, Rick Hall, whose name is signed to this instrument, being first duly sworn, signed and executed the instrument as the Declaration of Local State of Emergency, and that I signed willingly, and that I executed it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this closure shall occur during the approximate time period between 7:00 PM and 8:00 PM on December 01, 2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this closure is for the public purpose of the **Celebrate Downtown Parade**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that traffic from the closed portion of highway shall be detoured over routes with an all weather surface that can accept the anticipated traffic, which will be maintained to the satisfaction of the Department and which is conspicuously marked for the benefit of traffic diverted from the State Highway. (The parking of vehicles shall be prohibited on the detour route to allow an uninterrupted flow of two-way traffic.)* The detour shall be as follows: The parade will only be crossing the State route at an angle from Broadway Avenue to Western Avenue; therefore, a detour will not be necessary due to the ability to open the road to traffic as required.

*To be used when appropriate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the **City of Mattoon** assumes full responsibility for the direction, protection and regulation of the traffic during the time the detour is in effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the police officers or authorized flaggers shall at the expense of the **City of Mattoon** be positioned at each end of the closed section and at other points (such as intersections) as may be necessary to assist in directing traffic through the detour.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that police officers, flaggers and officials shall permit emergency vehicles in emergency situations to pass through the closed area as swiftly as is safe for all concerned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all debris shall be removed by the **City of Mattoon** prior to reopening the State Highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such signs, flags, barricades, etc., shall be used by the **City of Mattoon** as may be approved by the Illinois Department of Transportation. These items shall be provided by the **City of Mattoon**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the closure and the detour shall be marked according to the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an occasional break shall be made in the procession so that traffic may pass through. In any event, adequate provisions will be made for the traffic on intersecting highways pursuant to conditions noted above. (Note: This paragraph is applicable when the Resolution pertains to a Parade or when a detour is required)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that to the fullest extent permitted by law, the **City of Mattoon** shall be responsible for any and all injuries to persons or damages to property, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Illinois Department of Transportation, its officers, employees and agents from any and all claims, lawsuits, actions, costs and fees (including reasonable attorney's fees and expenses) of every nature or description, arising out of, resulting from or connected with the exercise of authority granted by the Department which is the subject of this resolution. The obligation is binding upon the **City of Mattoon** regardless of whether or not such claim, damage or loss or expense is caused in part by the act, omission or negligence of the Department or its officers, employees or agents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the **City of Mattoon** shall provide a comprehensive general liability insurance policy or an additional endorsement in the amount of \$1,000,000 per person and \$2,000,000 on aggregate which as the Illinois Department of Transportation and its officials, employees and agents as insureds and which protects them from all claims arising from the requested road closing. A copy of said policy or endorsement will be provided to the Department before the road is closed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this re Transportation so serve as a formal request for the peoperate as part of the conditions of said permission.		-

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS REAL ESTATE

WHEREAS, the City of Mattoon owns certain real estate parcels at Lake Paradise Subdivision including Lots 49 & 59; and

WHEREAS, State Statute 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4.1 enables municipalities to sell real estate, at a price of not less than 80% of the appraised value, if it is determined to be in the best interest of the municipality by a vote of two-thirds of the corporate authorities then holding office; and

WHEREAS, Phillip Goben owns a residence, and leases the real estate at Lots 49 & 59 of Lake Paradise Subdivision, also known as 3009 East Lake Paradise Road; and

WHEREAS, said real estate is further described on the attached sketch labeled Exhibit 'X', and the attached deed labeled Exhibit 'Y'; and

WHEREAS, Phillip Goben wishes to purchase said real estate at the appraised value of \$11,863.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council declared Lots 49 & 59 "no longer necessary or required for the use of the municipality" and "authorized management staff to negotiate contracts to sell said lots" by virtue of Resolution No. 2006-2642; and

WHEREAS, the City Council established certain Covenants, Restrictions, and Limitations for Lake Paradise Subdivision in a Declaration made May 16, 2006 and caused said document to be recorded at the Coles County Clerk and Recorder's Office as Document No. 0690359, said covenants are attached as Exhibit 'Z'.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MATTOON, COLES COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council determines that it would be inappropriate to offer this property to competitive bidding since the lease has already invested in permanent improvements on the

premises that cannot be conveniently separated.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to sign documents conveying, by Warranty Deed, attached as Exhibit 'Y', title to the real estate described in Section 3 of this ordinance to Phillip Goben in exchange for payment in the amount of \$11,863.00.

Section 3. The real estate to be conveyed pursuant to this ordinance is legally described as:

Lots 49 & 59 of Lake Paradise Subdivision, Paradise Township, Coles County, Illinois, commonly known as 3009 East Lake Paradise Road, Mattoon, Illinois.

Excepting any interest or estate in the minerals underlying the surface of the land which may have been heretofore conveyed or reserved, and all rights and easements in favor of any such mineral interest or estate.

Section 4. The Covenants, Restrictions, and Limitations for Lake Paradise Subdivision, Paradise Township, Coles County, Illinois, attached as Exhibit 'Z', shall run with the land, as provided by law, and shall be binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them and for the benefit of, and limitations on, future owners in such subdivision.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the City Council.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be effective upon its approval as provided by law.

Mayor Hall opened the floor for comments. Chief Hilligoss provided Firefighter Hefley's background over the past year with the Fire Department, noting he had met requirements and was enrolled in the paramedic class at Lake Land College.

Commissioner Cox seconded by Commissioner Closson moved to approve Council Decision Request 2023-2324, authorizing the employment of Anthony J. Nichols as a probationary firefighter for the Mattoon Fire Department effective February 09, 2023, contingent upon successful completion of background, physical and psychological exams.

Mayor Hall opened the floor for comments. Chief Hilligoss announced that Mr. Nichols had passed all requirements, was the 3rd generation of firefighters and would be attending the Academy after six shifts.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

CITY ADMINISTRATOR noted preparation of budgets including review of revenues and expenditures, Department Heads submitting their budgets and preparation of meetings with Department Heads; and reminded Council of the upcoming Chamber Annual Dinner. Mayor Hall opened the floor for questions with no response.

CITY ATTORNEY updated Council on the Robb Perry liquor license decision where the Illinois Liquor Commission upheld former Mayor Gover's decision to revoke his liquor license and Mr. Perry's 35 days to appeal to the Circuit Court, and the Quakenbush hearing where Judge Bovard provided Mr. Quakenbush an outline of expected improvements by April 13th. Commissioner Cox inquired as to the fines with the property remaining the same. Attorney Jones explained the City's option to fine Mr. Quakenbush up to \$750/day or Mr. Quakenbush could clean up the property to have the fines abated. Mayor Hall opened the floor for further questions with no response.

CITY CLERK noted preparation of the Department budget and the work comp audit; otherwise, business as usual. Mayor Hall opened the floor for questions with no response.

FINANCE announced the budget was coming together; distributed and reviewed the Revenue Tracking Report, unrestricted cash and no receipt of sales tax dollars. Mayor Hall opened the floor for questions with no response.

PUBLIC WORKS announced permission to bid on the bike trail for March 29th, completion of the Upchurch Streetscape plans while working toward the bidding process, and street sweeping commencement with 50 degree temperatures. Mayor Hall opened the floor for questions.

FIRE reported on calls for service, inspections and follow-ups, training; thanked Council for approving both Firefighter Hefley and Nichols; and announced new testing on April 29 for a hiring list, CAD training and an AFG grant for a new truck. Commissioner Graven asked for a firefighter count with Chief Hilligoss stating 25 until February 15th when Firefighter Herschberger was transferring to Urbana. Mayor Hall opened the floor for questions with no response.

POLICE reported on calls for service and 69 arrests; and reviewed the Police Year-End Report. Mayor Hall opened the floor for questions with no response.

ARTS AND TOURISM announced with the \$30,000 grant received a workshop series with community and student components including creatives: Mary Fons, Craig Titley, Christina Delay and Dr. Temple Grandin; and notified Council of upcoming events with Artworks, Lightworks, Heritage Park events and Bagel Bites. Mayor Hall opened the floor for questions with no response.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT announced several zoning requests including an unmanned fueling station, the use of Image Trend Software to monitor activities, the housing subdivision complete, Land Bank Authority, full partnership with a \$30,000 IDHA grant, and completion of Move-to-Mattoon with all five families to move to Mattoon in July. Mayor Hall opened the floor for questions with no response.

COMMENTS BY THE COUNCIL

Council congratulated Officer Schumacher, Firefighter Hefley and Firefighter Nichols. Commissioner Closson noted an advertisement for the Parks open position and additional projects planned for the Dog Park. Commissioners Cox, Graven and Phipps had no further comments. Mayor Hall updated Council on activities with the Housing Committee, sports complex, TIF funding for sports complex, grants, an IML meeting, and liquor ordinance revisions.

Commissioner Cox seconded by Commissioner Phipps moved to adjourn at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Hall declared the motion carried by the following vote: YEA Commissioner Closson, YEA Commissioner Cox, NAY Commissioner Graven, YEA Commissioner Phipps, YEA Mayor Hall.

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the U.S. Health and Human Services Secretary declared a public health emergency for the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Illinois has issued a disaster proclamation on March 9, 2020 due to the impact of the COVID-19 virus and has activated the State Emergency Operations Center; and

WHEREAS, the State Emergency Management Agency has declared a public health emergency due to the impact of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration has coordinated its response with other Coles County governmental entities.

The nature of the emergency is related to the COVID-19 virus which is causing or anticipated to cause widespread impacts on the health of members of the community.

During the existence of the Local State of Emergency, the Mayor shall execute such authority as provided under the Illinois Municipal Code, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act and Ordinance No. 2020-5430.

This Declaration of Local State of Emergency shall be filed with the City Clerk as soon as practicable.

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-5460

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 33 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

WHEREAS, Section 33.065 of the Municipal Code of the City of Mattoon, Coles County, Illinois, provides regulations for the Mattoon Arts Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mattoon Arts Council's Board of Directors from time to time reviews and recommends changes be made to the regulations; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Mattoon Arts Council's Board of Directors and the City of Mattoon, Illinois, deems it to be in the best interests to have Section 33.065 amended by this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mattoon as follows:

- **Section 1. Recitals.** The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.
- **Section 2.** Arts Council Regulations. Section §33.065(A)(2) of Chapter 33 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mattoon is hereby amended to read as follows:
- (2) Mission. The Mattoon Arts Council supports, develops, facilitates and promotes high-quality, affordable arts programs and activities events for people of all ages.
- **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application of any provision of this Ordinance, is held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such occurrence shall not affect other provisions of this Ordinance, or their application, that can be given effect without the unconstitutional or invalid provision or its application. Each unconstitutional or invalid provision, or application of such provision, is severable.
- **Section 4.** This ordinance shall be effective upon its publication and approval as provided by law. The Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.
- **Section 5.** All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon adoption.

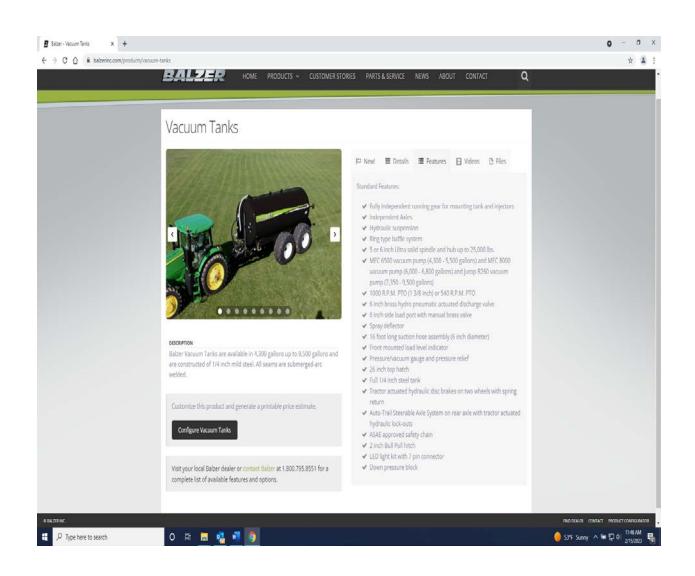
